

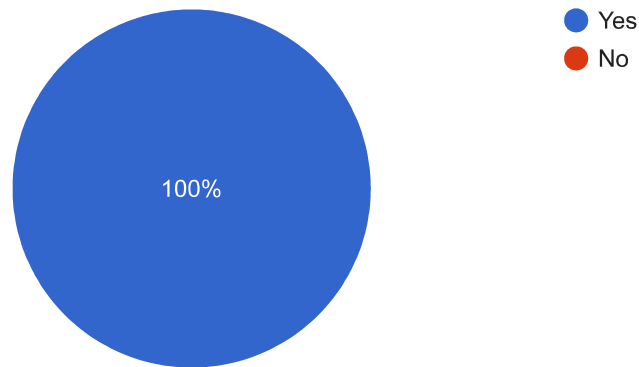

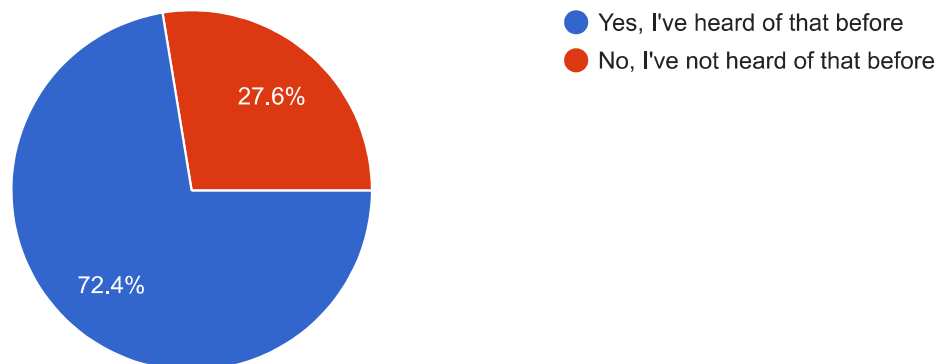
Yes or No questions - **Most translations (Universal)**

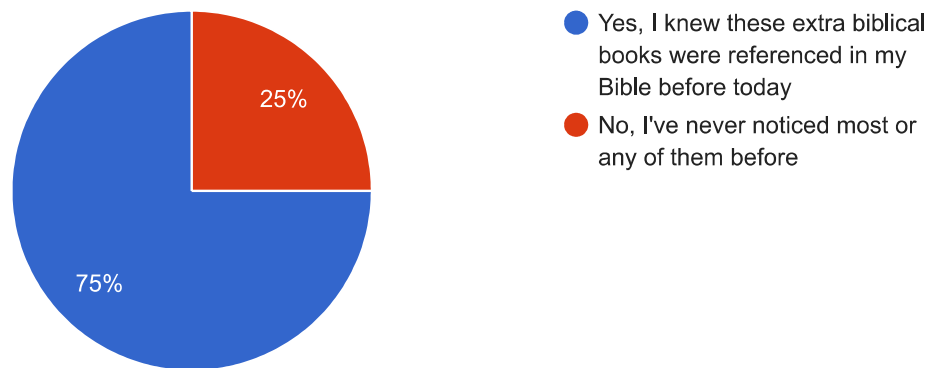

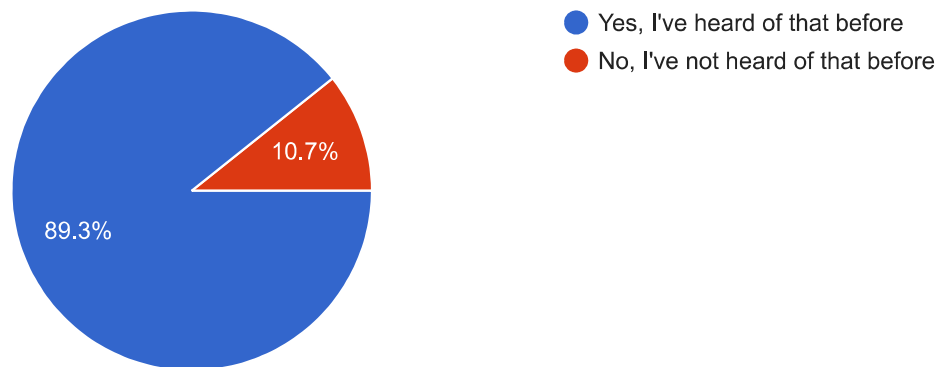




Question: Is this the first time you are hearing about a passage that says that they brought babies to Jesus to touch them? NOTE: (Not children to bless - babies to touch)

Luke 18: 15 (Most translations) - "And they brought unto him also **infants, that he would touch them:** but when his disciples saw it, they rebuked them. "

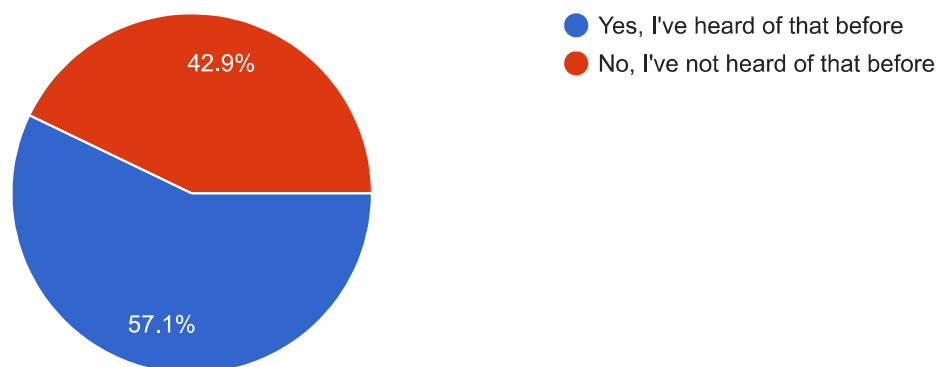

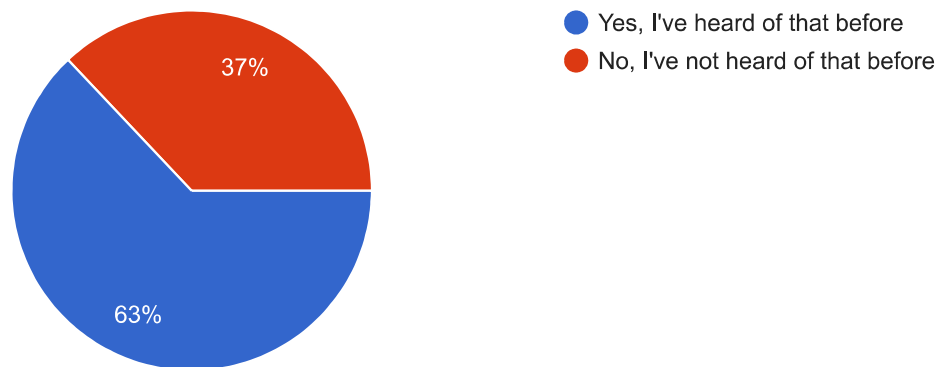




Question: Is this the first time you are hearing about any reference to woman with wings?

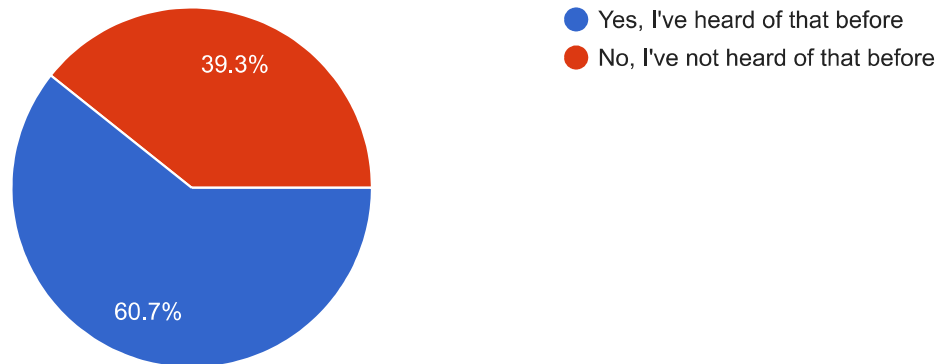




Question: Is this the first time you are hearing about a passage that talks about **sacrificing turtles**?

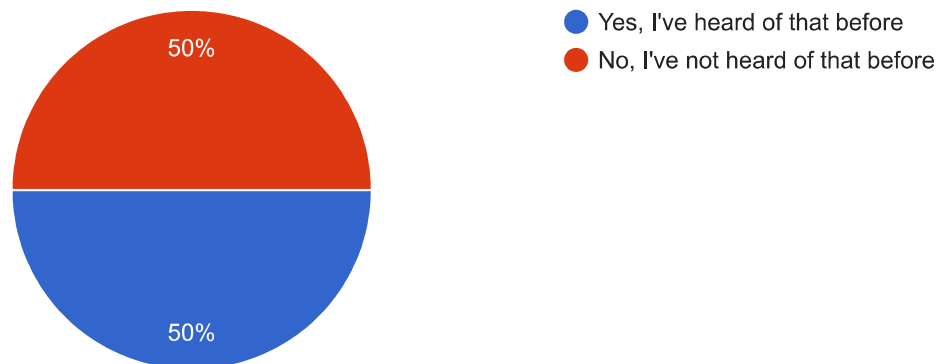

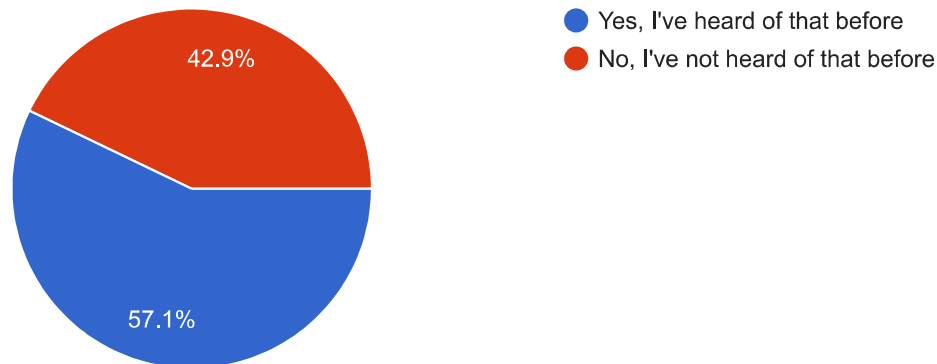




Question: We all remember *"the fool says in his heart there is no God,"* but is this the first time you are hearing about a different passage that says *"there is no God?"*

Isaiah 45:14 (KJV Only) "...they shall make supplication unto thee, saying, Surely God is in thee; and there is none else, **there is no God.**"

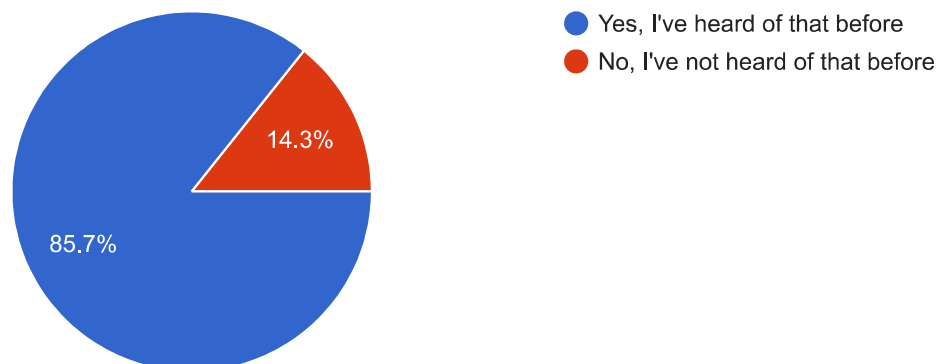
