

Supernatural Bible change list

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Introduction

Many people have comforted themselves with the idea that our testimonies can simply be brushed aside by suggesting that we're all just confused because of all the different renderings found in different modern versions of the Bible. **This list eliminates that objection.**

This combined list contains a variety of different types of supernatural Bible change examples, but all of the passages that we include are specifically chosen because they are either universal changes or King James only changes. By doing this, we eliminate the possibility that our testimonies could be caused by confusion as a result of different versions, modernizations, misprints, or variants.

- **Universal changes** have the same rendering in all versions, including the King James Version. "Jesus wept" (John 11:35) is an example of a universal passage. "Jesus wept" is always rendered as "Jesus wept" in every version without exception. So if we say a Bible change is universal, we are indicating that the rendering is identical across all versions, just like "Jesus wept," but we are also indicating that the way it now appears in every version is not what most people remember.
- **King James-only changes** are also exclusive in two ways. Firstly, these changes, as they are remembered and as they appear in our Bibles, would only appear in the King James Bible due to their unique Old English style using "thees" and "thous." However, what we also observe is that some changes are unique to the King James Version. In these changes, the King James Bible is changed, while all other versions are the same, but different from the King James Version.

Isaiah 45:14 is an example of this. The King James Version is the only one that renders this passage as "there is no God." Another example of a King James-only Bible change is Hebrews 6:1, where the word "elementary" has been removed, but only from the King James Bible.

The point here is that, by using only these two specific types of suspected Bible changes, we eliminate the possibility that our testimonies can simply be dismissed as the rantings of uneducated boobs with weak minds who are just befuddled by version confusion.

How can we be confused by versions if what we all remember has always been the same in every version? And remember, if you are going to rely on this explanation, you have to include yourself in the posse of lame brains that don't know their Bibles.

It's important to note that some changes are universal or King James—only, but they also appear the way everyone remembers them (unchanged) in a different book in the same version.

For example:

Luke 6:49 — “built an house upon the earth.”

Many Bible readers do not remember this “built an house upon the earth” wording, even though a more familiar rendering is still found in Matthew 7:26–27.

Matthew 7:26–27 — “for it was founded on the rock.”

You know, and I know, that the wording of “building his house upon the earth” is wildly unfamiliar, and the fact that it appears the familiar way in a different book in the same Bible should not convince you that there's nothing to see here. Don't you know your Bible? Don't you know that no book in your Bible ever used the word “earth” in this parable? Sure you do!

By carefully selecting passages that only meet these and other criteria, this list has eliminated the possibility that any form of confusion is causing the widespread, synchronized misremembering that has clearly been documented. You can experience this yourself with this list with anyone who knows their Bible.

The high level of unified misremembering that will result if you expose people to the passages in this list is therefore **not** caused by:

- Confusion by variations in different versions
- Confusion by modernizations, variants, or misprints
- Confusion by different renderings in other books within the same version

Additionally, as you can see from the table of contents, there are a variety of other types of changes that further dispel the suggestion that this can all be

explained away by the unreliability of human memory, because many of the changes have nothing to do with memory.

- Finally, if you claim that you are unmoved by these “high-sounding arguments” because they depend on some unproven math formula, and that you base your beliefs only on God’s eternal, unchanging Word, then I urge you to consider the following passages.
- If you insist on occupying some vaunted position of spiritual purity and present yourself as a person of integrity while insisting on the impossible notion that $1 + 1 = 3$, you place yourself in direct violation of all the following Scriptures that you say you are guided by.
 - (Passages that demand an honest, simple answer to a simple question) John 3:19–20, Romans 1:18–20, Proverbs 14:5, James 4:17, Acts 7:51, Proverbs 29:1, Proverbs 18:13, Proverbs 12:15, Hosea 4:6, 2 Thessalonians 2:10–12

Doctrinal paradoxes

Universal

Remember – even if you can somehow convince yourself that these abominations are the inspired word of God, you still have to ask yourself two questions;

- 1) Is this the 1st time this passage has ever come to your attention?
- 2) If yes, how is it possible that you never noticed it until now?

Remember – The passages that you are about to read appear in the KJV and virtually every translation with virtually identical renderings

Jihad Jesus slaying any who refuses to follow Him

- Luke 19:27 (Most translations) "But those mine enemies, which would not that I should reign over them, bring hither, and slay them before me."

Jesus Spitting in people's faces to heal them

- Mark 8: 23 (Most translations) - "And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought."

People drinking their own piss and eating their own dung

- 2 Kings 18: 27 (Most translations) - "But Rabshakeh said unto them, Hath my master sent me to thy master, and to thee, to speak these words? hath he not sent me to the men which sit on the wall, that they may eat their own dung, and drink their own piss with you?"

Isaiah engaging in fornication with a prophetess

- Isaiah 8:3 (Most translations) "Then I made love to the prophetess, and she conceived and gave birth to a son. And the Lord said to me, 'Name him Maher-Shalal-Hash-Baz. '"

Paul Robbing churches?

- 2 Corinthians 11: 8 (Most translations) - "I robbed other churches, taking wages of them, to do you service."

Sacrificing Female Sheep

- "Leviticus 4:32 - "And if he bring a lamb for a sin offering, he shall bring it a **female** without blemish."
- This female sheep thing is wildly unfamiliar to many people. They say, the **female** sheep thing really convinced me that the Bible was changing. So you can come up with any back story commentary you want, but we think you are lying to yourself. You know and I know that this was never in your Bible, and for many, it's the first time you are hearing about it. Having said that, you also have this mass of confusion to further wear out the saints (Dan 7:25)
- Exodus 12:5 "Your lamb shall be without blemish, a **male** of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats."
- Leviticus 3:1 "And if his offering be a sacrifice of peace offering, if he offer it of the herd; whether it be a **male or female**, he shall offer it without blemish before the Lord."
 - Female sheep, male sheep and both sheep

How many times are the 10 commandments listed in the Bible?

Do you ever remember any of the 10 commandments being included in a list that includes ceremonial laws? I've been in the word and ministry for 40 years and I just found out about this recently.

The Ten Commandments most famously appear in:

- Exodus 20:1–17
- Deuteronomy 5:6–21

However, Exodus 34:11–28 is being called a "renewed covenant", and verse 28 even says: *"he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments."* But the content of Exodus 34 is significantly different from the traditional Ten Commandments in Exodus 20.

Only 3 to 4 of the traditional Ten Commandments (no other gods, no idols, Sabbath, possibly coveting) appear in Exodus 34. The rest are replaced with ceremonial and covenantal laws unique to Israel.

Is this the first time you are finding out that any of these extra biblical books have been in your Bible and YOU DIDN'T KNOW IT? How is that possible?

We all remember this one...

- Is it not written in the book of Jasher (Joshua 10:13, 2nd Sam 1:17)

But have you ever heard of these?

- the book of Shemaiah the prophet (2nd Chronicles 12:15)
- Iddo the seer concerning genealogies (2nd Chronicles 12:15)
- the book of Nathan the prophet (1st Chronicles 29:29)
- the book of Gad the seer (1st Chronicles 29:29)
- the book of the acts of Solomon
- the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel. 1 Kings 14:19

There seems to be a lot more cannibalism in the Bible than I remember

- Ezekiel 5:10 (Most translations): "Therefore fathers will eat their sons in your midst, and sons will eat their fathers. I will inflict punishment on you and will scatter all your survivors to the winds."
- Micah 3:2-3 (Most translations): "You rulers hate good and love evil; you tear the skin from my people and the flesh from their bones. You eat the flesh of my people, strip off their skin, break their bones and chop them up like meat in a pot, like flesh in a cauldron."
- 2 Kings 6:28-29: (Most translations): "Give up your son so we may eat him today, and tomorrow we'll eat my son. So we cooked my son and ate him. The next day I said to her, 'Give up your son so we may eat him,' but she had hidden him."

- **Additional cannibalism scriptures:** Leviticus 26:29, Deuteronomy 28:53, Jeremiah 19:9, Lamentations 2:20, Ezekiel 5:8-10, Micah 3:2-3, Isaiah 9:19-20

There seems to be a lot more of men kissing men in the Bible.

- Genesis 27:26–27 — Isaac kisses Esau
- Genesis 33:4 — Esau kisses Jacob
- Genesis 45:15 — Joseph kisses his brothers.
- Exodus 4:27 — Aaron kisses Moses
- 1 Samuel 10:1 — Samuel kisses Saul).
- 1 Samuel 20:41 — Jonathan kisses David
- Acts 20:37 — And they began to weep loudly, and falling on Paul's neck, they kissed him.
- Romans 16:16 — Men greet each other with a holy kiss
- 1 Corinthians 16:20 — Men greet each other with a holy kiss
- 2 Corinthians 13:12 — Men greet each other with a holy kiss
- 1 Thessalonians 5:26 — Men greet each other with a holy kiss
- 1 Peter 5:14 — Men greet each other with a kiss of love

Genitals like donkeys

- Ezekiel 23:20 (Most translations) “There she lusted after her lovers, whose genitals were like those of donkeys and whose emission was like that of horses.”

Jesus touching babies

- Luke 18: 15 (Most translations) - "And they brought unto him also infants, that he would touch them: but when his disciples saw it, they rebuked them. ."

The disciples stop at the bar to tilt a few

- Acts 28:15 (Most translations) And from thence, when the brethren heard of us, they came to meet us as far as Appii forum, and The three taverns: whom when Paul saw, he thanked God, and took courage.

Streaking in the Bible

- John 21:7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt *his* fisher's coat *unto him*, (for he was naked,) and did cast himself into the sea.
- Mark 14:51 And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast about *his* naked *body*; and the young men laid hold on him:

Smashing babies against rocks makes you happy

- Psalm 137:9 - "Happy shall he be, that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones." (I know David prayed imprecatory prayers but I just found out about this recently. I think if this was in my Bible I would have known about it. Maybe not.

Female Angels or women with wings

- Zechariah 5:9) - "Then lifted I up mine eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came out two women, and the wind was in their wings; for they had wings like the wings of a stork: and they lifted up the ephah between the earth and the heaven."

666 appearing several more times in the bible in addition to the original reference in Revelations:

- Rev 13 –Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six.
- 1 Kings 10:14 / 2 Chron 9:13 Now the weight of gold that came to Solomon in one year was six hundred threescore and six talents of gold,
- Ez 2:13 The children of Adonikam, six hundred sixty and six.

Fornication & adultery condoned

- Hosea 4:14 I will not punish your daughters when they commit whoredom, nor your spouses when they commit adultery: for themselves are separated with whores, and they sacrifice with harlots: therefore the people *that* doth not understand shall fall.

Changes in various versions

Shaving Women's Parts

- Isaiah 7:20 (New International Version ONLY) ..."the Lord will use a razor....to shave your heads and "private parts" = "Pudenda" = Female genitals."

Masturbation (American Standard Version ONLY)

- Isaiah 27:12 "Jehovah will beat off His fruit"
 - There's only 3 explanations for this one. The translators are either incompetent, they are perverts or the Bible is changing. If you believe the Bible is perfect and flawless, then you can't keep suggesting that the atrocities found in this list can be explained away by a bad translation. How many times can you keep saying; "Well, it doesn't really mean that," before your followers say; "does this book ever mean what it says." Our Bibles are now laced with sexual innuendo like this and the devil is laughing at you because you are blinded by a superficial understanding of the doctrine of preservation.

Doctrinal paradoxes

King James Only

Blasphemy

The following changes are only found in the Authorized King James Bible

There is no God

- Isaiah 45:14 "...they shall make supplication unto thee, saying, Surely God is in thee; and there is none else, **there is no God.**" (Should be **there is no other God**)

Leaving the principles of Christ – (Elementary?)

This now teaches that you should no longer listen to anything Jesus says.

- Hebrews 6:1 "Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God
 - You know and I know that it should say "Therefore leaving the elementary principles" Stop lying to yourself!

Jesus is called a "Holy Thing"

- Luke 1:35 "And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also **that holy thing** which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God." (Should be the Holy One)

God the Father has a Father

- Revelation 1:6 "And hath made us kings and priests unto **God and his Father**; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen." (Should be His God and Father)

Revelation 1:13 (Jesus as Baphomet with female breasts)

- "Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about with the 'paps' with a golden girdle. Paps = mas-tos; from

the base of G3145; properly, female breast. **Did not use stethos - male breast**

Leviticus 12:8 Abominations (Turtles) offered in sacrifice

- Leviticus 12:8 "And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring **two turtles**, or two young pigeons; the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering" (**Should be two turtledoves**)
 - **Turtles - Strong's H8449 - transliteration - tôr**

It's important to note that the same word in the original is translated two different ways in the same paragraph.

- Leviticus 12:6 "And when the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a lamb of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a **turtledove**, for a sin offering,"
 - **Turtledove - Strong's H8449 - transliteration - tôr**

The only explanation I've heard to explain this abomination is that these two words were used interchangeably in those days.

My response is first of all, "how do you know?" Where are you getting all your certainty from. And even if you can cobble together some source that seems to indicate that in those days Turtle and Turtledove were used interchangeably, it still doesn't explain why the translators would translate them differently into English in the same paragraph. No! What you are looking at is proof positive that your KJV Bible is being supernaturally fiddled with by the devil with God's permission for the purposes of exposing wide spread Biblical idolatry in the church. Do you know Him, or do you just know the book?

It would also appear that God specifically forbids the sacrifice of Turtles (Tortoises)

- Leviticus 11:29-30 "These also shall be unclean unto you among the creeping things that creep upon the earth; the weasel, and the mouse, and the **tortoise** after his kind, And the ferret, and the chameleon, and the lizard, and the snail, and the mole."

Wouldn't a tortoise qualify as unclean or be considered defective

- Leviticus 1:3-4 Do not offer anything that has a defect, because it will not be accepted."

These additional passages are no longer coherent and further indicate a supernatural change instead of a poor choice on the part of the translator.

Song of Solomon 2:12

- The flowers appear on the earth; the time of the singing of birds is come, and the voice of the **turtle** is heard in our land. (Birds have a voice, turtles do not)

Jeremiah 8:7

- Yea, the stork (BIRD) in the heaven knoweth her appointed times; and the turtle (REPTILE) and the crane (BIRD) and the swallow (BIRD) observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the LORD. (Isn't it obvious that this used to say **turtledove** so they were all birds? Come on!)

Allegiance with the underworld

Ephesians 6:12 (Compare to Titus 3:1)

- For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against **principalities, against powers**, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. (This is correct)

Titus 3:1

- Put them in mind **to be subject to principalities and powers**, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, (Should be rulers)

Sexual Inuendo

Titus 1:8 KJV

- For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy

lucre; But a lover of hospitality, a **lover of good men**, sober, just, holy, temperate;

Luke 17:34-35

- "I tell you, in that night there shall be **two men in one bed**; the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left." **"Two women shall be grinding together**; the one shall be taken, and the other left."
 - Job 31:10 "Then let my wife grind unto another, and let others bow down upon her" (Grinding = Euphamism for sex).

1st Samuel 18:3

- Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he loved him as his own soul. And Jonathan took off the robe that *was* on him and gave it to David, with his armor, even to his sword and his bow and his belt.
 - **Is it just me, or do you also never remember David stripping down in from of Johnathan?**

1st Samuel 20:41

- And as soon as the lad was gone, David arose out of a place toward the south, and fell on his face to the ground, and bowed himself three times: and they kissed one another, and wept one with another, until David exceeded.
 - The KJV translates Strong's H1431 in the following manner: [magnify](#) (32x), [great](#) (26x), [grow](#) (14x), [nourish up](#) (7x), [grow up](#) (6x), [greater](#) (5x), *miscellaneous* (25x).
- גָּדַל gâdal, gaw-dal'; a primitive root; properly, to twist (compare H1434), i.e. to be (causatively make) large (in various senses, as in body, mind, estate or honor, also in pride):—advance, boast, bring up, exceed, excellent, be(-come, do, give, make, wax), great(-er, come to... estate, things), grow(up), increase, lift up, magnify(-ifical), be much set by, nourish (up), pass, promote, proudly (spoken), tower.
 - I don't remember the "until David exceeded" part, and if your honest neither do you. So with all of the back and forth between these two culminating in something that can easily be characterized as an erection, (ie to causatively make large in

various senses, as in body), can you understand why we might believe our Bibles are under attack.

John 21:7

- "Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved saith unto Peter, It is the Lord. Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt his fisher's coat unto him, (**for he was naked,**) and did cast himself into the sea."

Mark 14:51–52

- And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast **about his naked body**; and the young men laid hold on him: And he left the linen cloth, and fled from them naked.

James 2:3

- And ye have respect to him that weareth the **gay clothing**, and say unto him, Sit thou here in a good place; and say to the poor, Stand thou there, or sit here under my footstool.

Cross dressing / LBGT / Homosexuality

Isaiah 49:23

- "And kings shall be thy **nursing fathers**, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth,

and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.”

Sucking the breasts of kings

- Isaiah 60:16 (Most translations) - "Thou shalt also suck the milk of the Gentiles, and shalt suck the breast of kings: and thou shalt know that I the LORD am thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.”

Job 21:24

- His **breasts are full of milk**, and his bones are moistened with marrow.

Warning against cross dressing

- Deuteronomy 22:5 "The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are abomination unto the LORD thy God.”

Girdles & Bonnets

- Exodus 28:40 “And for Aaron's sons thou shalt make coats, and thou shalt make for them **girdles, and bonnets** shalt thou make for them, for glory and for beauty.”
- Revelation 15:6 "And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with **golden girdles**.”

Lace

- Exodus 28:37 "And thou shalt put it on a **blue lace**, that it may be upon the mitre; upon the forefront of the mitre it shall be.”

Aprons

- Genesis 3:7 "And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves **aprons**.”

Linen breeches

- Exodus 28:42 "And thou shalt make them **linen breeches** to cover their nakedness; from the loins even unto the thighs they shall reach."

Deuteronomy 27:20

- Cursed be he that lieth with his father's wife; because he uncovereth his father's **skirt**. And all the people shall say, Amen.

Acts 22:25

Corn, was native to the Americas and was unknown in the Old World before Columbus' voyages in 1492. It could not have existed in Israel in biblical times. Historical evidence shows that maize spread to Europe, Africa, and the Middle East in the 16th and 17th centuries, long after the Bible was written. The existence of the word corn in the Bible is evidence of supernatural changes.

Psalms 65:13

- The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with **corn**; they shout for joy, they also sing.

Corn in the Bible? (mentioned 102 times)

John 12:24

- Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a _____ (corn / grain) of wheat fall into the ground and die
- John 12:24 "Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a **corn** of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit."

KJV pronouns such as Thee and thou are being supernaturally replaced with modern pronouns.

- Matthew 5:11 Blessed are ye, when men shall revile **you**, and persecute **you**, and shall say all manner of evil against **you** falsely, for my sake.

Other books written in the KJV vernacular

Example # 1 Shakespeare (to morrow vs tomorrow)

Shakespeare's plays and sonnets were written in Early Modern English. It is from the same period as the KJV and shares many linguistic features. Here is how the word "tomorrow" is spelled in Shakespeare's;

***Macbeth*, Act Five, Scene Five.**

"She should have died hereafter;

There would have been a time for such a word.

Tomorrow, and tomorrow, and tomorrow"

Compare to:

- Exodus 8:23 (KJV) – **"to morrow"** "And I will put a division between my people and thy people: **to morrow** shall this sign be."

Example # 2 Pilgrim's Progress (Vail vs veil)

Another book written in that period in the KJV vernacular is *Pilgrim's Progress*. At the very end of the book, in the section called "The Conclusion," you have the word "veil," not "vail."

"Put by the curtains, look within my **veil**,
Turn up my metaphors, and do not fail,
There, if thou seekest them, such things to find,
As will be helpful to an honest mind."

Compare to:

- Exodus 34:33 "**vail**" "And till Moses had done speaking with them, he put a **vail** on his face."

Example # 3 (for ever vs forever)

The American Revolution: Written in the Style of Ancient History is a 1793 account of the American Revolution written by Richard Snowden. It is written in the King James old English style.

On Page 9 we read; "In death's eternal deep **forever** bound, Breathlefs, they lie extended on the ground."

Compare to:

- 1 Chronicles 16:34 "**for ever**" "O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good; for his mercy endureth **for ever**."

Example #4 "Thoroughly vs. thoroughly."

In this example, we have a word being misspelled in one place, and then spelled correctly in another. This anomaly appearing in the Authorized KJV text is found in:

- Exodus 21:19 (KJV) "If he rise again, and walk abroad upon his staff, then shall he that smote him be quit: only he shall pay for the loss of his time, and shall cause him to be **thoroughly** healed."
 - Strong's H 7495 raw-faw' Transliteration rāpā'

 - Strong's H8254 - shaw-kal' transliteration šāqal

- Daniel 5:9: "Then was king Belshazzar greatly troubled, and his countenance was changed in him, and his lords were **astonied**."
 - Strong's H7672 sheb-ash Transliteration šəḇaš
