The Ten Commandments most famously appear in:

- Exodus 20:1–17
- Deuteronomy 5:6–21

However, Exodus 34:11–28 is being called a "renewed covenant", and verse 28 even says: "he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments."

But the content of Exodus 34 is significantly different from the traditional Ten Commandments in Exodus 20. Only 3 to 4 of the traditional Ten Commandments

(no other gods, no idols, Sabbath, possibly coveting) appear in Exodus 34. The rest are replaced with ceremonial and covenantal laws unique to Israel.

Did Sarai give Hagar to Abram to cohabitate with her or to be his wife?

 Genesis 16:3 (most translations) "And Sarai Abram's wife took Hagar her maid the Egyptian, after Abram had dwelt ten years in the land of Canaan, and gave her to her husband Abram to be his wife."

Who cast down his rod before Pharaoh?

 Exodus 7:10 (most translations) "And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent."

Matthew 8:28-34

- In Matthew 8:28-34, it mentions that Jesus met two men possessed by demons in the region of the Gadarenes (or Gerasenes). However, in Mark 5:1-20 and Luke 8:26-39, the accounts focus on one man, often referred to as the "Gadarene demoniac."
